

Stephen Hollingsworth to Levi Hollingsworth, Richmond, 29 November 1787 (excerpt)

... the Constitution seems to gain ground it has been debated for three nights in the Union society, & its expected the yeas, & nays, will be taken the Next night, for the Particulars of this, & every other Matter in the line of Polliticks you are Referred to Messrs Pollard, & Ford, who have been in the Midst of them while in haste your Affectionate Brother
